Welcome – Principal, Jeff Estes

Approval of minutes from previous meeting – Heather Marme

Principal's Remarks – Jeff Estes

- Facility Update
 - Every Wednesday the principal meets with district personnel and the construction crew. There was no damage to the school from Hurricane Irma.
 - The school is being built ahead of schedule and we expect the school to be in open in July with all parts of the campus ready. Administration may be able to move in to the offices at the end of May, beginning of June.
- Homecoming
 - It was a success. The students enjoyed themselves and everyone left with a smile.
- Golden Apple Nominations
 - Golden Apple is a teacher recognition program by the Foundation for Lee County Public Schools.
 - We had 13 out of 15 teachers nominated.
- Vision 2020 & School Goals
 - The Vision 2020 video was played for members from the Lee County School District website.
 - A handout was provided to members which included a description of Vision 2020 and our school's goals for this school year.
 - The 2017-2018 school goals are:
 - ELA proficiency 60% (54% proficient in 16-17)

- Math proficiency 70% (68% proficient in 16-17)
- Science proficiency 52% (44% proficient in 16-17)
- We have approval from the school district to open next year with only 9th and 10th graders. Every year a new class will be added. This will help us hire and staff the school completely and help us obtain highly qualified teachers.
